

MINUTES


On 28 February 2023, at 13 hours, an ad hoc jury was held, composed of Professor Claire Bright, Chair, Professor Athina Sachoulidou and Professor Laura Iñigo Álvarez, to assess the applications for Research Scholarship (BI) No. 1/2023, for the Foundation for Science and Technology, through the financial support of the FCT/MCTES through national funds (PIDDAC), and within the scope of the Strategic Project of CEDIS, Centre for R&D in Law and Society (UI0714), 2020-2023, to collaborate with the knowledge NOVA Centre on Business Human Rights and the Environment, hosted by CEDIS.

The jury began by verifying that six applications had been submitted to the call. Following this, the jury carried out a formal analysis of the process, verifying that all applications complied with the requirements set out in the competition call.

Following analysis of the elements presented by the candidates, according to the evaluation parameters set out in the competition call, all five applications were admitted and scored, and the jury decided to award the scholarship to the candidate ranked under **number 4** (who obtained the highest score overall) :
