

MINUTES

On May 30, 2022, at 9.15 am met the ad hoc jury composed of Professor Fabrizio Esposito, who presided, Professor Vera Lúcia Raposo and Master Tiago Bessa, to assess the applications to the Research Grant No. n. 6/2023 to be awarded in the context of the activity of the Knowledge Centre WhatNext.Law, hosted by the Centre for Research and Development on Law and Society (CEDIS - UID714) of the Nova University Law School.

The jury began by verifying that the following applications were submitted in response to the call for applications:

Afterwards, the jury carried out a formal analysis of the application files and found that the candidate Aline Bratti did not meet the specific requirements of the call for applications, namely because she is not attending, at the time of application, the 2nd Cycle of Studies at NOVA School of Law, after the end of the taught part. Considering that this requirement is not possible of being remedied, the jury had to exclude this candidate.

The other candidates meet the general and specific requirements of the call for applications.

After the analysis of the elements presented in the applications according to the evaluation parameters foreseen in the call, the following candidate was admitted:

The jury based its decision on the following weighting criteria set out in the call for applications:
